

Champdeniers / Parthenay

La Vélidéale

Niveau Medium Riding from Champdeniers to Parthenay, you'll cross the beautiful village of Saint-Marc-la-Lande which boasts a magnificent collegiate church, a commandery (once owned by a military religious order), a medievalinspired garden and a conservation orchard. As you cycle on further, note how granite stone gives way to limestone as you enter an area known as the Gâtine Poitevine. Riding merrily along, you'll be delighted to encounter a charming village or two, a mysterious river, a legendary centaur, a ford, old landscapes composed of hedge-divided fields, a medieval town... Arriving at Saint-Pierre-de-Parthenay-le-Vieux, admire the sublime church, its construction even attributed by legend to the Fairy Mélusine... Reaching the outdoor leisure centre, or Base de Loisirs, at Parthenay, dismount to enjoy a picnic on the banks of the Thouet River before heading into town to discover its historic centre and fine heritage.

The route

Signposting is shared with *La Vélo Francette*. This stage is mainly on roads shared with motorized traffic, with two stretches on segregated paths: one stretch of greenway around Mazières-en-Gâtine; and one around Parthenay, along the Thouet River.

- Parthenay: the Base de Loisirs (or outdoor leisure centre); the medieval town, the historic quarter featuring two medieval gateways, the medieval-inspired Jardin Férolle and Rue de la Vau St-Jacques, the last boasting 100 timberframe houses; the Musée Georges Turpin (on art and history); the CIAP (exhibiting on local heritage and architecture).
